Dinner on November 9th and lunch on November 10th are not provided. Students will have a chance to purchase their own food. This is an overnight trip. There will be separate hotels for boys and girls. Students will share rooms at the hotel monitored by Upper Canada DSB staff and should pack clothing and supplies needed overnight for the trip.
